## **Summary Minutes of the meeting held on Friday 3 May 2019**

### **National Risk Assessment (NRA)**

GIBA Council was advised that work continues in respect of the preparation of Guernsey's NRA. GIBA Council considers it appropriate for GIBA and relevant sector associations to be involved in the review and consideration of the draft NRA prior to its finalisation and ultimate publication. This view was shared with the senior officers of the States of Guernsey present at the meeting.

### **States of Guernsey Future Digital Services (FDS)**

GIBA Council received a high level briefing on the FDS initiative from senior officers of the States of Guernsey. This followed publication of the relevant Policy Letter for consideration by the States of Deliberation at a future meeting. It was explained to Council that the initiative would consistently deliver quality IT services to the States of Guernsey whilst controlling revenue costs, allow IT to act as a key enabler of transformation across the States of Guernsey and should make a meaningful contribution to sustaining and developing Guernsey's digital economy. Assuming that the States of Deliberation approve the proposals as set out in the Policy Letter it is anticipated that further more technical based briefings will be provided to GIBA Council.

### **Guernsey Financial Services Commission**

The GFSC 2018 Annual Report is due to be published during the week commencing 6 May.

### **Guernsey Finance**

Preparations for the City Week event and the City UK Conference were progressing.

A bilateral meeting between Guernsey Green Finance and UK Green Finance was to be held during the City Week event and it is hoped that a cooperation agreement will be finalised at that time.

### **Technical: Revision of Laws**

The various feedback statements have been published by the Guernsey Financial Services Commission and are available on their website. Associations have been asked to provide their comments to the Chair of GIBA and GIBA's Technical Resource in order that they can understand the views of the associations in respect of the feedback provided by the Commission.
